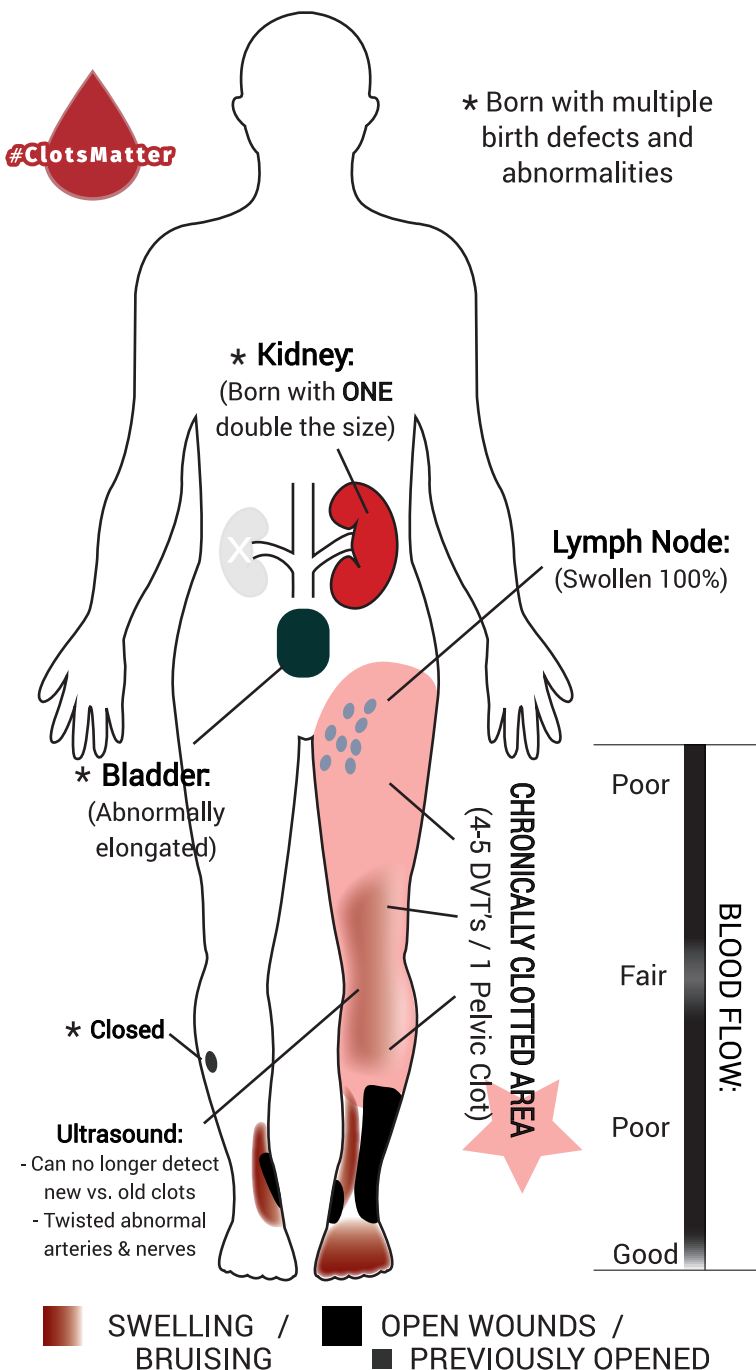


Martin has suffered from blood clots (DVT's) for 20 years and chronic open wounds for almost 10 years. This is his story.

Medications: Pain Management | Anticoagulants | Nerve Damage | Inflammation | Skin Care
Wound Care: Coban2 Compression | Biatain IBU | Bactigras | 4" Cling
Allergies: Silver | Nickel



Left Leg:

- 4-5 Known DVT's (Upper/Lower Leg)
- 1 Clot in the pelvic area
- 2 Open wounds
- Average pain 8-10/10
- Chronic swelling
- Constant stiffness
- Both wounds never retract
- Both wounds create a lot of leakage
- Swells due to walking and temperature

Outer Wound:

- The 1st to open 8+ years ago
- Doesn't change much in size and depth
- Constantly battling infections

Inner Wound:

- Constantly changes
- Creates the most pain 10/10
- Always irritated by socks and shoes
- Creates major discomfort sleeping

Right Leg:

- 1 Known DVT in the calf area
- 1 Open wound, 1 closed wound
- Average pain 5-7/10
- Minimal swelling
- Medium stiffness

Outer Wound:

- The 1st to close around 2013-2014
- Bled out twice (1-2 pints) in public
- Was connected to an artery

Inner Wound:

- Constantly changes
- Almost closed completely back in 2014
- Has now opened larger than before
